Regina constituents will be able to interact with candidates for the federal election representing all parties at Regina Public Library's *Meet and Greet All Candidates* event.

The event takes place on Monday, September 9, from 5 PM to 8 PM on the mezzanine at Central Library. Candidates from every political party will meet voters and answer questions about important issues in informal, one-to-one conversations. Rather than a networking event or an occasion for canned speeches, *Meet and Greet All Candidates* lowers barriers between politicians and the public by creating a space where voters can lead the discussion.

For the Regina-Lewvan riding, customers will meet Winter Fedyk, from the Liberal Party, Jigar Patel from the NDP, Naomi Hunter from the Green Party, and Trevor Wowk, from the People's Party of Canada. From the Regina Qu'Appelle riding, Dale Dewar from the Green Party will attend, as well as Tracey Sparrowhawk from the People's Party of Canada. For Regina Wascana, we will have Michael Kram from the Conservative Party, Tamela Friesen from the Green Party, Mario Milanvski from the People's Party of Canada, while Ralph Goodale will attend from 7 PM to 8 PM.

"We support political literacy and we want to provide barrier-free ways to engage with Canada's democratic election process," says Nancy MacKenzie, Manager of Community Engagement and Programming. "This event is a great way to bring the public and their political representatives closer in a respectful bipartisan setting."
